- 10. Transports only authorized students.
- 11. Reports all accidents immediately to the authorities and Supervisor of Transportation and completes required reports.
- 12. Enforces regulations against tobacco usage and eating on the bus.
- 13. Promotes safety and enforces safety rules with students on the bus.
- 14. Undergoes a physical examination and attends driver training classes annually.
